## **February, 2020 Financial Report**

The income and expense report as of February 29, 2020 is as follows:

### FUND BALANCES REPORT

The February 29, 2019 checkbook balance was **\$3,353.29**.

### MONTHLY BUDGET ENVELOPE GIVING

February envelope and loose plate giving was **\$6,592.00**.

### TOTAL INCOME FOR REPORT PERIOD

February income from all sources was **\$10,993.25**.

### TOTAL EXPENSES FOR REPORT PERIOD

February expenses were **\$9,053.14**.

### SUMMARY

**Income in relation to expenses for February 2020 was \$1,940.11.**

This balance figure is somewhat misleading. Though a major renter missed their January payment, they did pay double for February; nevertheless, it took all of this month for us to catch up on **our** missed payments. While the true balance is still positive, it is several hundred less than shown in the transaction report. March will be a month of correction and we can only hope (pray!) for moderate seasonal weather.

**Please mention any projects you feel need doing or any concerns you have about repairs to Mike in written form. He will pass them on to the appropriate person. Everyone is encouraged to maintain good stewardship.**
